# **OUR OBLIGATIONS AS ORGANIZER**

We are in charge of organizing accommodation and meals and providing the necessary materials / tools for work.

We cover covers the costs of accommodation, meals and travel. Travel expenses will be paid in full to the participant upon completion of the activity.

We provide a mentor who is available to you for the entire duration of the activity.

We pay you a daily allowance in the amount of 5 euros. The allowance will be paid in full upon your arrival.

We organize educational workshops.

## **ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD**

Participants will be accommodated in the Archaeological House and the local family farm. Meals included are breakfast, lunch, and dinner + a supply of snacks for the late hours of the night.





### **WHAT TO BRING**

In addition to comfortable clothing, it is advisable to bring firmer sneakers or off-road shoes, as part of the activity will take place on congested terrain. In addition, do not forget your ID card, health insurance card and personal hygiene items (toothbrush, kaladont, towel, etc.). If you use some medications, don't forget them.

### **VOLUNTEERING**

Volunteering lasts 2 weeks (14 days) in June. The activity lasts up to 6 hours a day, including the educational activities listed below. After the activity, volunteers will have educational workshops and meetings with mentors for a maximum of 2 hours. The rest of the time is for free activities and socializing. During the week, volunteers have 2 days off, which means a total of 4 days off during volunteering.

## **INSURANCE**

Foreign volunteers who do not have a European Health Card will be additionally insured through CIGNA health insurance. Volunteers coming from countries outside the European Union will be registered for CIGNA health insurance by the organizers.
